The measurement of Objectives and Targets will form the basis for continuous improvement initiatives across the NCS organisation to reduce and eliminate environmental harm.
- Ensure that all Workers understand their Environmental obligations and responsibilities of this Policy through inductions, training, position descriptions, provision of environmental materials and other methods deemed necessary by Management.
- Review this Policy by Senior Management on an annual basis in order to establish and maintain its relevance and appropriateness in meeting the NCS Objectives and Targets and relevance to the organisation’s environmental activities.
